

Museum Floor Accessibility Map

The Outside, Inside
It's easy to forget that you will encounter the same obstacles as any street. Dropped kerbs have been installed but we must ask visitors to treat the museum arena as an outside space and be aware of items such as the steep kerbs, cobbles and tram tracks for example.



The thick yellow lines represent pavements.



The yellow striped areas represent levelled surfaces (in tarmac, carpet, wooden block or slate).



The red double lines represent dropped kerbs.



The areas marked in pink on the map do not offer the ease of access of modern day if you are in a **mobility scooter**. This is due to the historical nature of the museum.
